



Reading Record

The reading record is your chance to communicate with your child's teachers to tell them how your child got on with their book. If you can be specific with your comments, it will help us to ensure the books your child brings home are closely matched to their phonic ability.

Read well

They read the book almost fluently, only stopping to sound out the word 'time'.

Phonic books

This is the book which matches our phonic scheme and the sounds taught in class. When you hear your child read, you could make a comment for each read based on a different skill.

Read 1/2 - Comment on the use of phonics.

Read 3/4 - Comment on fluency and expression.

Read 5 - Comment on comprehension.
