



## Everything I need to know about Daisies



### What do I need to wear to Daisies?

- I can wear any clothes to Daisies, as long as I don't mind them getting dirty or wet.
- I can also wear a Nursery jumper which can be purchased from the school office (in red or blue).
- I will need a pair of wellies which will stay in Daisies so we can enjoy those puddly days!
- I need suitable shoes for running around in – no crocs or laces etc.
- Everything needs to be named, even socks please!



### What happens when I arrive?

- I will either walk to Daisies or park in the parent carpark off Trunk Road.
- I will come in through the Daisy garden door
- I will put my belongings away on my peg and cubby hole.
- I will choose something to play with. My grown-up can stay with me until I feel settled and then they will say good-bye and I will stay in Daisies (Covid restrictions dependent).

### What happens when I am at Daisies?

- I will have lots of fun playing inside or outside as I chose.
- I will take part in small group sessions.
- I will have a snack and milk or water.
- I will use the school library to bring home a weekly library book (which will start later in term).
- I will be able to use the school grounds as part of my learning, including: the pond, vegetable patch, adventure playground and woodland area.



### What happens when it is time to go home?

- I will get my belongings ready for home time.
- I will meet my grown-up in the Daisy garden.

### How will my grown-ups know what I am learning?

- Regular opportunities to share your learning journal with your grown-up.
- Parent meetings will take place over the year, to share your learning with your grown-up.
- Parent stay and play sessions to take place over the year (Covid restrictions dependent).

### Other information

- A book bag is useful for bringing library books and letters to and from school. These can be purchased from the school office.
- I will need a water bottle every day with only water in.
- Please name everything!
- We are a nut-free school, so if you bring a packed lunch this needs to be nut-free and healthy.
- If someone other than your grown-up is picking you up, we will need to be told this when you arrive.
