<u>Elf Run</u>

<u>Curriculum</u>

Please remember to look on the school website – Curriculum/class name – for information about what the children will be learning this term.

For Year R, click on Poppies and Snowdrops/Topics in Year R and find Spring 1.

For Year 1 and Year 2, we have changed things slightly – we have Knowledge Organisers for each half term for different subjects e.g history. Again, click on Curriculum/Class name/Topics in Year 1 or 2 and at the moment you will then see Autumn 1 and Autumn 2. Spring 1 will be added soon. Please ask if you need any help.

Book Viewing Friday 3rd February 9-9.30am/2.40 – 3.15pm

This will be an opportunity for the children in Year R, Year 1 and Year 2 to share their learning journeys or books with you so that you know what they have been learning in school. You will have the chance to sit quietly with your child in the hall and chat with them and celebrate their achievements. You will also be able to look at their books at Parents Evening the following week.

As we did in October, you will be able to book your appointment time for your 10 minute slot on Arbor or the Arbor App which seemed to work well. Log on and click on Guardian Consultations. The system will ONLY be live from Monday 30th January.

Yr 2 SATs Information

In Year 2, the children complete Standard Assessment Tests in Reading and Maths during May to support our teacher assessment. These are nothing to worry about and the children will probably not know that they are doing them – as they will be part of their normal learning. Rather than having a specific meeting about these (which wouldn't be very exciting!), we thought we would have a powerpoint running in the hall during Parents Evenings (it will just keep running on a loop so you can join before or after your appointment) that explains everything and examples of the

booklets children complete will be out for you to look at. I will also be around to answer any questions you may have.

Yr 1 Phonics Meeting Thursday 2nd March 7-8pm

Some of you may be aware that children in Year 1 will do a Government Phonics Screening Check in June. This is nothing to worry about. Come to the meeting and you will find out what this entails, what phonics your children are learning in Year 1 and how you can support at home.
