# Knowledge

- Textiles are flexible materials woven from fibres.
- Textiles are used to make clothes, linen, towels, mats and a wide variety of other products.
- Lots of materials are considered as textiles, for example, cotton, silk, wool, nylon and felt.
- Different materials have different properties which make them suitable for a variety of purposes.
- Sewing is using a needle and thread to join two pieces of material together.
- ❖ A template should be used to create two identical shapes
- Joining techniques can include running stitch, glue, over stitch, stapling.
