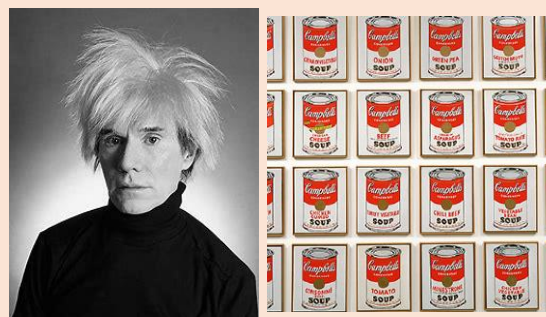
- ❖ A portrait is a picture of a person, depicting the head, neck and shoulders.
- ❖ A self-portrait is a drawing or painting which the artist makes of their own face.
- ❖ Printing is a way to make an exact copy of text and images on paper.
- ❖ Pop art is a style of art based on simple bold images of everyday items painted in bright colours.
- ❖ Andy Warhol created pop art, including 'Marilyn Diptych' and 'Campbell Soup cans'.
- ❖ Andy Warhol used a technique called screen printing to create lots of prints that look the same.
- ❖ Andy Warhol used bright colours and repeated patterns in his work.

Safeguarding

- ❖ Children to wear protective clothing when painting.
- ❖ Use deep tubs of water, with wide bases when painting to avoid spillages.
- ❖ Don't leave paintbrushes standing in tubs of water or paint to avoid spillages,
- ❖ Children with allergies to wear protective gloves.
