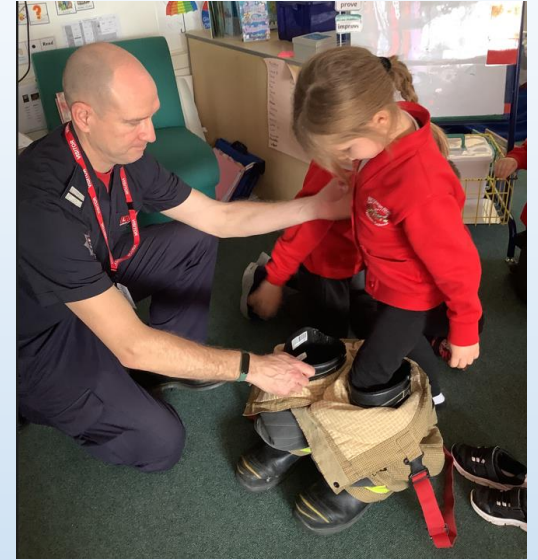

Same as in Year 1!



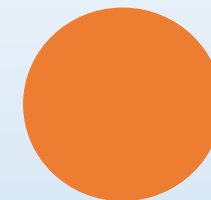
# End of Day Routines

Let us know of any different people collecting.

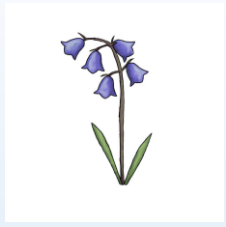

# Reading



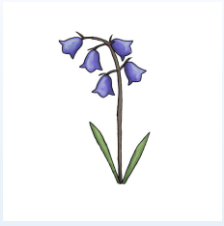
- Similar to Year 1
- Children will have:
  - A phonics book which includes the phonics that have been taught so far in Year 1/2 and which your child should practise. This will be changed by a class adult when appropriate, usually once a week. (Children will not have a phonics book if they are reading without needing to use phonics! Teachers will inform you of this).
  - A reading book with coloured book band. This can be changed as often as you want. Class adults indicate in reading records when your child can change their colour band.
  - A red reading record. Please write any 'home reads' in this book.
  - **Please could the children have their reading books with them every day.**
- 5 times a week.
- Reading records will be collected in every Friday. We will check frequency of reading and make sure children have got new books if they haven't already changed them in the week.

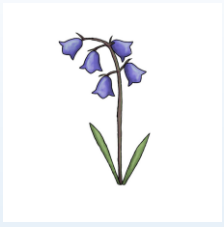

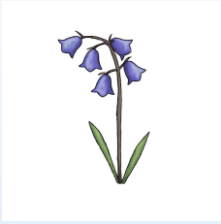

# Writing

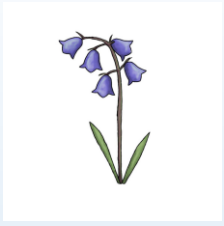

# Maths

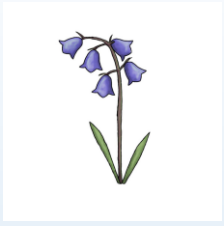


- National Curriculum and Hampshire Planning

- Homework to address individual needs.

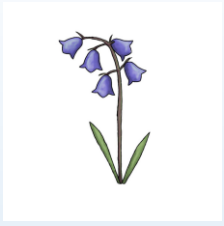

For example, last year:

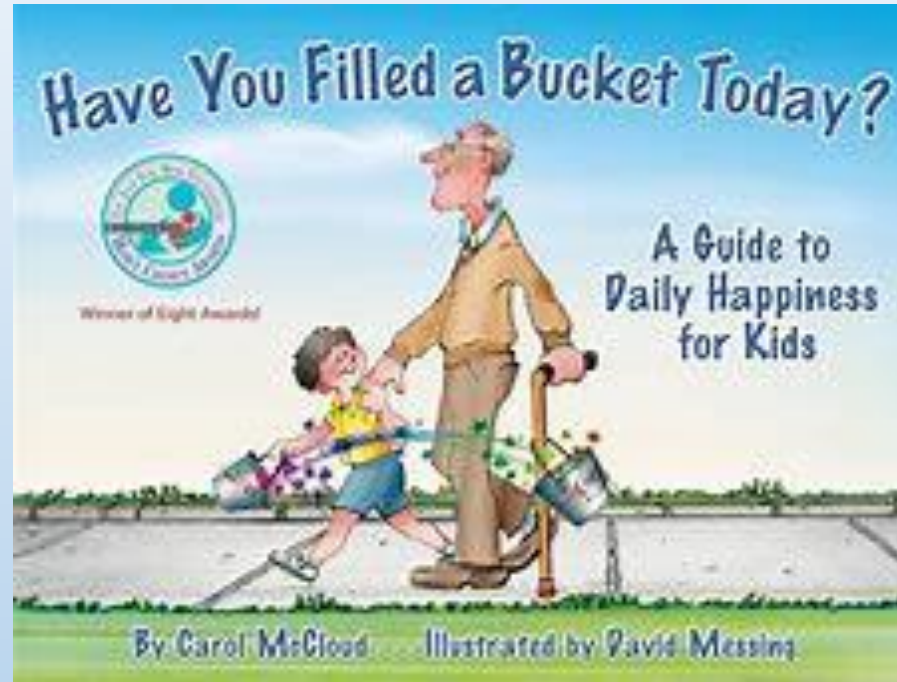
Spring: Trip G Live- Guildford

Smaller trips e.g. Science walk

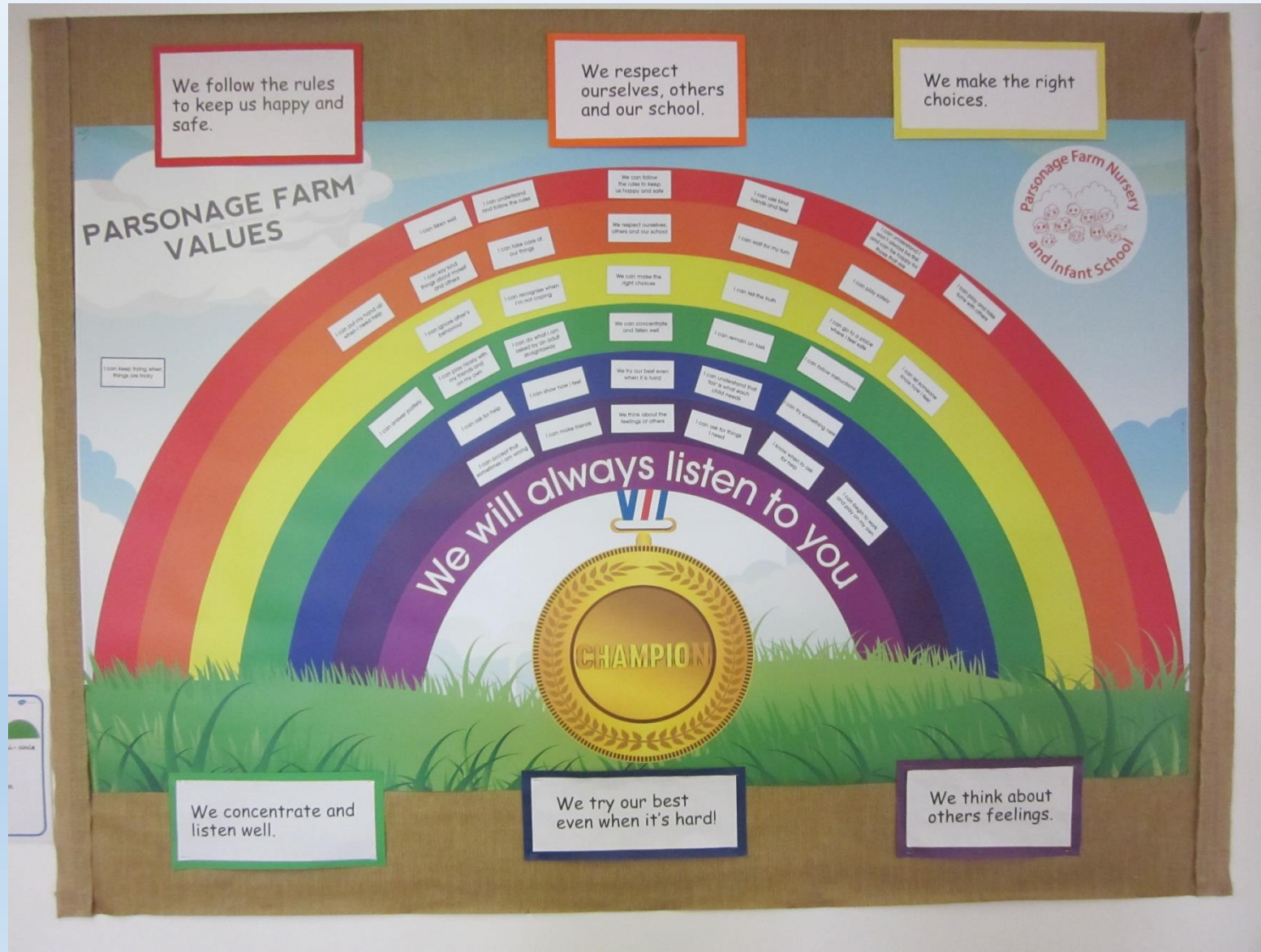

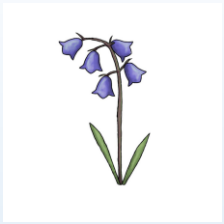




# Other bits and bobs...
