

Translate Pages in Chrome (Android)

Translate a Web Page

1. Open Chrome on your Android device.
 2. Go to the page you want to translate.
 3. A notification will appear at the top—tap the language you want to translate to.
 4. If you want to change the default translation language:
 - Tap **Settings > More languages**.
 - Choose your preferred language.
 5. To always translate pages in that language:
 - Tap **Settings > Always translate pages in [language]**.
 6. If Translate doesn't appear, refresh the page. Some languages may not be supported.

Manually Request Translation

If no notification appears:

1. Tap the three dots (More) next to the address bar.
 2. Tap **Translate**.
 3. To enable translation for a specific language:
 - Tap the language and choose **Offer to translate**.

Manage Translation Settings

- Change your default translation language.
 - Add, remove, or reorder your preferred languages.
 - Turn translation on or off.
 - Manage lists for:
 - Languages you never want translated.
 - Languages you always want translated.

Change Chrome's App Language

1. Open Chrome.
2. Tap **More > Settings > Languages**.

3. Under “Chrome’s language,” tap the current language.
4. Choose a new language from the list.
5. After it downloads, tap **Restart** in the toolbar.
6. When you see “Language ready,” the change is complete.
