

Translate Webpages in Microsoft Edge

Automatic Translation

- When you visit a page in a language not listed in your **Preferred languages**, Edge will ask if you want to translate it.
- The **Translate icon** appears in the address bar.

Translate a Page

1. Open the page in Edge.
2. A translation panel will appear.
3. Choose the language you want to translate to.
4. Click **Translate**.
5. To always translate from that language, check **Always translate from [Language]**.
6. To skip translation:
 - Click **Not now** to skip once.
 - Click **Never translate [Language]** to stop future prompts for that language.

Note: You can reopen the translation panel later even if you chose “Never translate.”

Manually Translate a Page

If automatic translation is turned off:

1. Click the **Translate icon** in the address bar.
 2. Choose your target language.
 3. Click **Translate**.

BACK Revert to Original Language

1. Click the **Translate icon** in the address bar.
 2. Select **Show original**.
-

Turn Translation On or Off

1. Click **Settings and more** (three dots) > **Settings**.
2. Go to **Languages**.
3. Toggle **Offer to translate pages that aren't in a language I read**.

Note: Edge uses your system's default language unless you change it.
