

Use the Translate App on iPhone

Translate Text or Voice

1. Open the **Translate app**.
2. Choose the language you want to translate to.
3. To switch languages, tap the **Swap** button.
4. Choose one:
 - **Text:** Tap “Enter text,” type or paste your phrase, then tap **Next** or **Done**.
 - **Voice:** Tap the **Listen** button and speak.

Note: Translation happens as you type or speak.

What You Can Do with a Translation

- **Play audio:** Tap the **Play** button.
 - **Change speed:** Hold the Play button, then choose a speed.
 - **Full screen:** Tap **Enter Full Screen** to show someone.
 - **Save:** Tap the **Favourites** button.
 - **Copy:** Tap the **Copy** button.
 - **Delete:** Swipe left and tap **Delete**.

View Saved Translations

1. Open the Translate app.
 2. Tap **Favourites** to see saved phrases.
 3. Favourites sync across devices signed into your Apple ID.

Translate a Conversation

1. Open the Translate app.
2. Tap **Conversation**.
3. Choose:
 - **Text:** Tap “Enter text,” type or paste, then tap **Done**.
 - **Voice:** Tap **Listen** and speak.

Extra Options:

- Tap **Play** to hear the translation.
 - Tap **More Options** > **Play Translations** to hear audio automatically.
 - Tap **Auto Translate** to let iPhone detect when each person speaks.
 - Tap **View** > **Face to Face** so both people can see their side of the chat.

Handle Words with Multiple Meanings

1. Translate a word or phrase.
 2. Tap the highlighted word to:
 - Choose a different meaning.
 - Pick masculine or feminine forms (if available).
 3. To hide gender options, tap **More Options** > **Show Grammatical Gender**.

Use AirPods for Live Translation

If you have an Apple Intelligence-enabled iPhone and AirPods:

- Use **Live Translation** to talk with someone in another language.
 - You'll hear their words in your language and vice versa.
