- ❖ Yayoi Kusama was born in Japan on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 1929 and is still alive.
- ❖ She makes lots of different types of art - paintings, sculptures, performance and installations - they have one thing in common - dots.
- ❖ Yayoi Kusama created sculptures in the shape of pumpkins and flowers.
- ❖ Sculpture is an art form made in three dimensions.
- ❖ Clay is moist sticky earth.
- ❖ The primary colours are red, yellow and blue. Mixing these together make secondary colours which are, orange, purple and green.
