Theme: Belonging in Christianity Concept: Belonging

Knowledge

Children will learn that:

- ❖ Christians follow the teachings of **Jesus** and this helps them to feel they **belong** to each other and to the **church**.
- ❖ The **gospels** contain the stories about **Jesus** in the **Bible**.
- ❖ **Jesus'** first followers were the 12 **apostles** and some of them were fishermen.
- ❖ People **belong** to different groups for different reasons.
- ❖ Many others followed **Jesus**, such as the crowds who came to hear him teach.
- ❖ **Christians** use stories about **Jesus** to decide how to live today. They listen to his stories, go to church, pray together and work for charity.
