- ❖ Worship and prayer

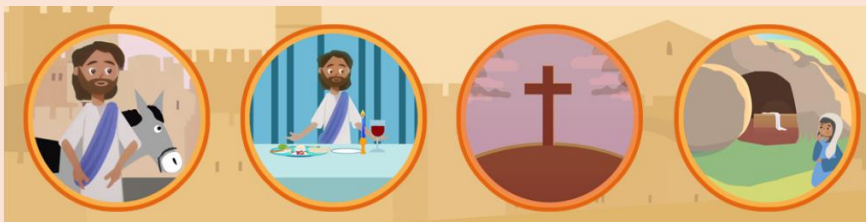
### Skills
