Knowledge

Children will learn that:

- ❖ Water is an important part of rituals in both Christianity and Hinduism
- ❖ Routines and rituals are different and talk about what makes them different
- ❖ Water is used as part of a Christian Baptism ceremony
- ❖ For Hindus the River Ganges is extremely important.
