Dear Parents,

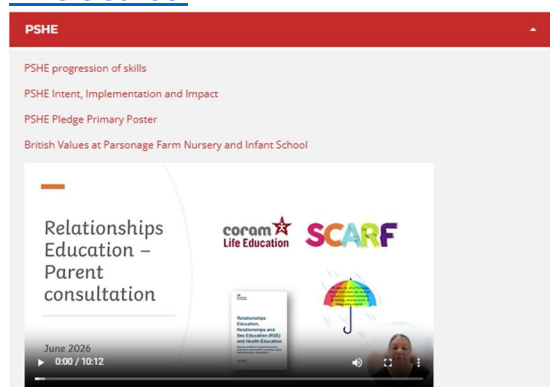
